Forgive my hidden faults.**
- 13 Keep your servant also from wilful sins;  
may they not rule over me.  
Then I will be blameless,  
innocent of great transgression.
- 14 May these words of my mouth and this  
meditation of my heart  
be pleasing in your sight,  
Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.**
