It is traditional to renew our Baptismal Vows at Easter. This will be included in our 9.30am service on Easter Day for those who wish to do so.



**Green Team Tip of the Week** to help you be even better stewards of God's lovely creation (and probably save you money too!).

### **Tip 14 - Eat locally grown produce**

Eat locally grown produce over imported if you can to cut down on the massive carbon footprint created by transporting our food across the globe.

It's a strange reality that in the UK, for example, we export a large portion of our locally caught fish, (premium healthy oily fish (mackerel, herring) and premium shellfish, (£2 billion) only to import the fish we actually eat! (White fish like cod £3.5 billion) This "food swap" uses vast amounts of fuel for ships and planes.

By choosing seasonal, locally sourced produce—or better yet, growing a few veg in your own garden or a window box—you bypass the "food miles" entirely. It's fresher, tastier, and much kinder to the planet than a punnet of strawberries that has flown miles, in March!

Finally, remember, even the combined might of All Saints and St Anthony's can't save the planet alone, so **SPREAD THE WORD!**
