- 9 Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you.
- 10 **Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the one who trusts in him.**
- 11 Rejoice in the Lord and be glad, you righteous; sing, all you who are upright in heart!
