Bishop's report on the Sanderstead Team Ministry. Bishop Jonathan and Chris Skilton, our Archdeacon, met with the PCC and DCCs on 8th April. The Report by the Archdeacon of Dorking recommends that the Team Ministry be brought to an end, and the parish of Sanderstead reconstituted. No decision has been made. The Bishop said there was no current proposal from the diocese as a whole to dispose of any of the buildings; nor any proposal to reduce the number of stipendiary posts funded from the diocese.
