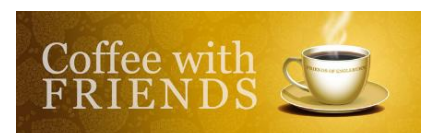
Wednesday 22 July - PCC MEETING, 7.30pm

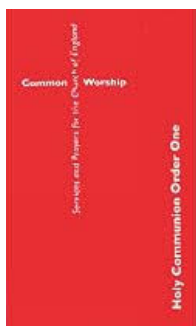
Thank you so much for your send off and your prayers. Thank you also for the gift voucher and plant. We will spend some time thinking about how to use the voucher.

Once a month we hold a brief quiet reflective Holy Communion.

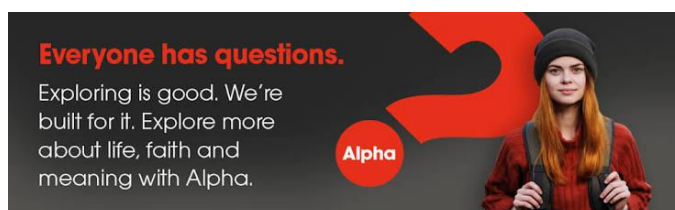
If we were to hold this WEEKLY, would you take up that opportunity?
