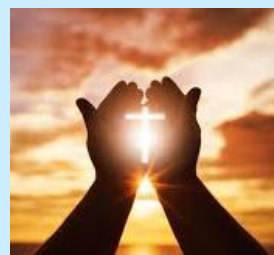

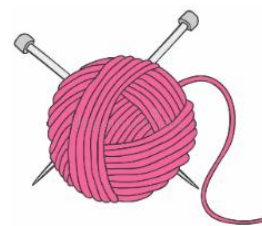
COFFEE POT - Friday 2 October, 10am -12pm

DONATIONS – ‘YOUR OLD BAG. THEIR NEW BEGINNING’

Sanderstead and Selsdon Rotary Club, in partnership with Bags of Hope Projects UK, are collecting **good-quality, pre-loved schoolbags** and redistributing them to children who lack basic educational equipment. Some children walk 3–5 kilometres each way to school, carrying their books in their hands or in cardboard boxes. Heavy rain can destroy their learning materials, while long journeys in hot conditions make carrying books without a proper bag particularly difficult. Meanwhile, here in the UK, many perfectly usable schoolbags are left forgotten in cupboards, garages and lofts when children grow older or simply want a new style. Please can you search your home for unused schoolbags and bring them to Church on Sunday or leave in the Hall Lobby?
