and their lives ebbed away.**

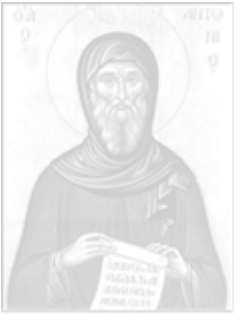
**⁶ Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble,
