while in a foreign land?**

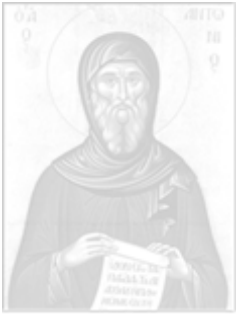
**⁵ If I forget you, Jerusalem,
