for I meditate on your statutes.**

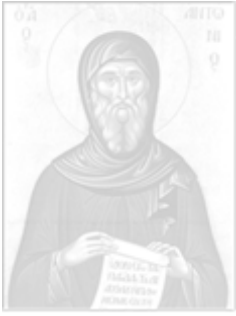
**¹⁰⁰ I have more understanding than the elders,
