**Response to official information request for any information on the proposed railway station at Whenua Tapu.**

I refer to your request for official information transferred to us from NZTA on 30 September 2020.

We have processed your request under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987.

We do not hold any information on a proposed railway station at Whenua Tapu beyond it being shown as a conceptual idea in the Growth Strategy 2048 spatial plan. The map showing the potential future railway station in the Growth Strategy is appended.

The option of a railway station at this location was a high-level conceptual idea that was discussed with Greater Wellington Regional Council for the Growth Strategy project. The feasibility of this idea would need to be explored further and supported with evidence at some point in the future if it is considered for implementation.
