Changing the Rural Lifestyle Zone minimum allotment size is councils way of freeing up land for housing expansion – currently the minimum size is 5 hectares, although im not totally opposed to reducing the plot size I think dropping it to 2 hectares ie: a 60% reduction is a leap too far. I would like to see council consider somewhere in between 2-5 hectares - thereby preserving as much of the rurality in the area as possible and maintaining the open green space that denotes rural living.

### Relief sought

Limit the reduction of RLZ plot size so that the minimum size is 3.5 hectares and not the proposed 2 hectares.
