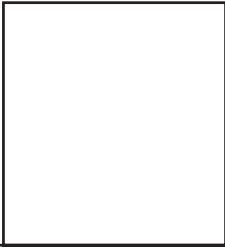

ΟΡΟΙ ΔΗΜΟΠΡΑΣΙΩΝ
