Provision made for new areas to be included in the SNA's.

A major area that continues to be ignored is the inclusion of new SNA's. Areas that people want to protect and undeveloped areas (and areas that are difficult to develop) that are not currently included in a SNA but would after a length of time (30 years) with or without positive interference become SNA's. Note that SNA's can also be areas that would provide a corridor for flora/fauna but are not currently vegetated. Why do we continue to talk of "remaining biodiversity"? These areas can be expanded on in more appropriate areas that have little or no economic effect. It is not a now or never proposal which is how it is being managed. Set up that green belt in the currently rural land and again you will increase biodiversity with a lower economic effect.
