Minute 11 – Hearing Stream 3 Witness Conferencing

1. The Hearing Panel have now had the opportunity to review the expert evidence filed for submitters and consider it would be assisted by expert conferencing on three sets of issues, as follows:
 - (i) Ms Dangerfield’s evidence for Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga in relation to scheduling of the interior of Gear Homestead and a selection of Austrian state houses;
 - (ii) Mr Partridge’s evidence on defining tree root protection areas, soil extraction methods within root protection areas, minimum qualification levels for technician arborists and permitted activities within root protection areas;
 - (iii) Mr Sullivan in relation to identification of appropriate Fault Hazard Zones on the Kenepuru Landing site.
2. Each witness is requested to confer with their Council counterpart (Messrs Vossler and Bowman in relation to historic heritage issues, Mr Saxon in relation to notable tree issues and Dr Litchfield in relation to seismic hazard issues) following the protocols in the Environment Court Practice Note in relation to expert conferencing.
3. The Panel directs that expert conferencing reports be lodged not later than 1pm on Wednesday 1 December identifying points of agreement on the above issues and, where experts disagree, a brief commentary on specific

points of disagreement.
