## Minute 32 – Stream 4 Follow Up

- During the course of its site visits on 17 March, while passing through Plimmerton, the Hearing Panel noted a reasonably substantial fence on Steyne Avenue screening the rail line from the road (and the properties on the other side of the road).
- Counsel for KiwiRail is requested to file a Memorandum advising whether the function of this fencing is indeed to provide screening, or whether it also provides a degree of acoustic mitigation benefitting those properties on the other side of the road.
- If the fencing does have acoustic benefits, KiwiRail is requested to advise whether the extent of those benefits has been quantified.
- Desirably, a response from Counsel for KiwiRail might be provided by Friday
  8 April, but if more time is required to obtain the information sought, Counsel is requested to advise the Hearing Administrator when it will be available.
