



LIMITED PRODUCT WARRANTY

20 Year Warranty Terms

Peelclear™ provides this warranty to cover the long-term integrity, adhesion, removability, and protective paint function of the Peelclear removable paint system.

01 Purpose

Peelclear™ provides this 20 Year Limited Product Warranty ("Warranty") to cover the long-term integrity, adhesion, removability, and Protective Paint Function of the Peelclear removable paint system when installed, maintained, and removed in accordance with Peelclear specifications.

Peelclear is engineered as a removable, non-destructive paint system intended to provide temporary surface transformation and protection while supporting the preservation of suitable underlying surfaces when properly installed, maintained, and removed.

Scope of warranty. Peelclear warrants the performance of the Peelclear Product as a removable protective paint system. Peelclear does not independently warranty, insure, or guarantee the pre-existing condition, adhesion, stability, quality, repair history, or long-term performance of any OEM paint, refinished paint, repaired panel, prior coating, or other Underlying Surface.

This Warranty applies only to qualifying Product performance failures resulting from verified defects in the Peelclear Product and is subject to the terms, conditions, exclusions, limitations, maintenance requirements, and eligibility requirements contained in this Warranty.

This Warranty is not an insurance policy and does not cover the vehicle itself, the Underlying Surface itself, installer workmanship, third-party materials, or third-party services except to the limited extent expressly stated in this Warranty.

02 Definitions

Peelclear	"Peelclear" means the manufacturer or seller of the Peelclear product.
Product	"Product" means Peelclear removable paint materials manufactured and sold by Peelclear, including approved Peelclear base coat and approved Peelclear top coat system components. Product does not include labor, installation services, removal services, tools, surface preparation, third-party coatings, third-party materials, or third-party services, except to the limited extent expressly approved as a warranty remedy under this Warranty.
Peelclear System	"Peelclear System" means the complete approved Peelclear paint system installed on a vehicle, including approved Peelclear base coat and approved Peelclear top coat components.
Certified Installer	"Certified Installer" means a shop, installer, dealer, or distributor authorized by Peelclear to participate in the Peelclear Warranty Program and submit warranty registrations through the Warranty Portal.
Product Integrity	"Product Integrity" means the ability of the Peelclear System to maintain adhesion, cohesion, removability, structural stability, and intended system performance under Normal Automotive Use when properly installed, maintained, and removed in accordance with Peelclear procedures.

Protective Paint Function	“Protective Paint Function” means the product’s intended function as a removable paint layer designed to help separate and shield a Suitable Underlying Surface from normal environmental exposure, ordinary surface contamination, and Normal Automotive Use when properly installed, maintained, and removed in accordance with Peelclear procedures. Protective Paint Function does not mean that the Product prevents all scratches, chips, impact damage, chemical damage, staining, environmental damage, substrate failure, repaint failure, or damage caused by improper installation, improper maintenance, improper removal, non-approved materials, or pre-existing Underlying Surface conditions.
Treated Area	“Treated Area” means the portions of the vehicle where the Product was installed.
Suitable Underlying Surface	“Suitable Underlying Surface” means an OEM or properly refinished surface that is structurally sound, fully cured, stable, properly adhered, and free from known peeling, delamination, corrosion, oxidation, instability, prior paint failure, or other conditions that may affect Product performance, adhesion, removability, or substrate preservation.
Underlying Surface	“Underlying Surface” means any surface to which the Product is applied, including OEM paint, refinished paint, primer, repaired panels, body panels, wraps, vinyl, paint protection film, plastics, trim, prior coatings, or previously repaired surfaces.
Original Owner	“Original Owner” means the person or entity that owned the vehicle on the Installation Date and whose vehicle was registered for warranty coverage through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved registration process.
Installation Date	“Installation Date” means the installation date recorded in the Warranty Portal based on the installer record, invoice, or proof of installation.
Product Purchase Price	“Product Purchase Price” means the amount paid for the Peelclear Product used on the affected Treated Area, excluding taxes, shipping, labor, installation, removal, reapplication, installer markup, third-party materials, and any other charges.
Defect	“Defect” means a material manufacturing failure of the Peelclear Product that causes the Peelclear System to fail to maintain Product Integrity or perform its Protective Paint Function under Normal Automotive Use when properly installed, maintained, and removed in accordance with Peelclear specifications.
Premature Yellowing	“Premature Yellowing” means abnormal and material discoloration of the cured Peelclear System caused by degradation of the Product itself beyond normal expected aging and environmental exposure. Premature Yellowing does not include discoloration caused by contamination, chemical exposure, environmental fallout, improper maintenance, neglect, staining, lighting conditions, viewing angle, substrate influence, or normal aging.

Peeling Edge Failure	"Peeling Edge Failure" means lifting, peeling, or separation of the Peelclear System at an edge, seam, panel boundary, or termination point when caused by a verified Defect in the Product and not by improper installation, improper surface preparation, contamination, impact, abrasion, pressure washing, cutting, trimming, Removal activity, or use of non-approved materials.
Normal Automotive Use	"Normal Automotive Use" means standard personal vehicle operation under ordinary road and environmental conditions. Normal Automotive Use does not include racing, track use, commercial abuse, industrial exposure, repeated chemical exposure, fleet abuse, off-road abuse, marine exposure, extreme operating conditions, or use outside Peelclear written instructions.
Removal	"Removal" means any act of peeling, lifting, pulling, dissolving, cutting, or otherwise detaching the Product from the Underlying Surface.
Warranty Portal	"Warranty Portal" means Peelclear's warranty registration and warranty management system located at app.Peelclear.com or any other Peelclear-approved system.
Controlled Documents	"Controlled Documents" means Peelclear's current written installation procedures, aftercare instructions, maintenance requirements, check-in requirements, claim evidence requirements, and warranty program requirements published or made available by Peelclear.
Customer Acknowledgment and Release	"Customer Acknowledgment and Release" means the customer-facing acknowledgment and release document executed by the vehicle owner prior to installation, using Peelclear-approved language or a substantially equivalent form approved by Peelclear.
Installer Participation Requirements	"Installer Participation Requirements" means the warranty participation obligations accepted by Certified Installers through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved system.

03 Warranty Term and Ownership

This Warranty remains effective for twenty (20) years from the Installation Date for the Original Owner, provided all eligibility requirements are continuously satisfied.

Non-transferable: This Warranty is non-transferable and terminates immediately upon any sale or transfer of vehicle ownership unless Peelclear expressly approves transfer in writing.

The twenty-year warranty period applies to qualifying Product Integrity failures, adhesion failures, removability failures, and Protective Paint Function failures caused by verified Defects in the Product.

The twenty-year warranty period does not guarantee indefinite cosmetic perfection, freedom from wear, permanent preservation of appearance, or identical performance under all vehicle, substrate, environmental, installation, maintenance,

04 Eligibility Requirements

Warranty eligibility requires compliance with all applicable Peelclear system procedures, maintenance requirements, installer participation requirements, and warranty registration requirements.

To remain eligible for coverage:

- The Product must be purchased from Peelclear or an authorized Peelclear source.
- The Product must be installed using approved Peelclear system procedures.
- Only approved Peelclear system components may be used, including Peelclear-approved top coat components.
- The installer must be a Certified Installer in good standing at the time of installation.
- The installer must obtain a signed Customer Acknowledgment and Release prior to any vehicle preparation, surface preparation, or Product installation.
- The installation must be registered through the Warranty Portal within the required registration period.
- The Original Owner must comply with applicable aftercare and maintenance procedures.
- Required warranty check-ins must be completed through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved process.
- Claims must be submitted within the required claim notice period.
- The affected Treated Area must not be altered, repaired, removed, refinished, modified, or reinstalled before written authorization by Peelclear, except where required for safety.

Non-approved components. Use of any non-Peelclear-approved top coat, coating, additive, reducer, modification, or third-party component may result in denial of warranty coverage for the affected Treated Area. Failure to satisfy eligibility requirements may affect warranty coverage or result in denial of warranty eligibility.

05 Warranty Registration and Check-Ins

Warranty registration must be completed within thirty (30) days of the Installation Date through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved registration process.

REGISTRATION MAY REQUIRE:

- Vehicle owner information.
- Vehicle identification information.
- Installation date.
- Installer information.
- Proof of purchase.
- Installation invoice.
- Product system details.
- Photographs of the completed Treated Area.
- Confirmation that the Customer Acknowledgment and Release was signed prior to installation.

3 YEAR CHECK-INS / PERIODIC CHECK-INS MAY REQUIRE:

- Vehicle photographs.
- Care confirmation.
- Maintenance attestation.
- Condition review.
- Confirmation of compliance with Peelclear aftercare requirements.

Failure to complete required warranty check-ins may affect continued warranty eligibility.

06 Customer Acknowledgment and Release Requirement

Prior to any vehicle preparation, surface preparation, or Product installation, the installer must obtain a signed Customer Acknowledgment and Release from the vehicle owner. The Customer Acknowledgment and Release must disclose and acknowledge, at minimum, the following:

Peelclear is a removable paint system designed and warranted, subject to this Warranty, to provide a temporary Protective Paint Function over a Suitable Underlying Surface.

Peelclear warrants the performance of the Peelclear Product as a removable protective paint system, but does not independently warranty, insure, or guarantee the pre-existing condition, adhesion, stability, quality, repair history, or long-term performance of any OEM paint, refinished paint, repaired panel, prior coating, or other Underlying Surface.

The Warranty covers qualifying failures where the Peelclear System fails to maintain Product Integrity, adhesion, removability, or Protective Paint Function due to a verified Defect in the Product.

Surface protection, removability, appearance, and final results may vary depending on substrate condition, repaint history, prior repairs, prior coatings, environmental exposure, maintenance, installation quality, and removal procedures.

Non-OEM paint, refinished panels, repaired surfaces, prior bodywork, weakened paint systems, improperly cured surfaces, or unstable substrates may increase the risk of lifting, delamination, peeling, adhesion loss, or surface damage during installation or Removal.

Peelclear does not cover substrate damage caused by pre-existing surface conditions, unstable paint, prior refinishing, improper surface preparation, improper installation, improper Removal, non-approved materials, customer misuse, third-party work, or failure to follow Peelclear aftercare instructions.

The installer performing the work is an independent business and is not an employee, agent, legal representative, franchisee, or partner of Peelclear.

The vehicle owner is responsible for following Peelclear aftercare and maintenance procedures to support Product performance, substrate preservation, removability, and warranty eligibility.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the vehicle owner must acknowledge and release Peelclear from claims, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses arising out of or relating to Underlying Surface conditions, pre-existing paint or paint conditions, installer workmanship, third-party materials, improper maintenance, improper Removal, unauthorized repairs, or failure to follow Peelclear procedures, except for the limited remedies expressly available for a covered Defect under this Warranty.

Eligibility requirement. A warranty registration is not eligible unless the required Customer Acknowledgment and Release was signed before any vehicle preparation, surface preparation, or Product installation began. The installer is responsible for obtaining, retaining, and producing the signed Customer Acknowledgment and Release upon request by Peelclear. Failure by the installer to obtain, retain, or produce the required Customer Acknowledgment and Release may result in denial of warranty eligibility.

07 Installer Participation Requirements

Certified Installers participating in the Peelclear Warranty Program acknowledge and agree that:

- They are independent businesses and are not employees, agents, franchisees, legal representatives, partners, or joint venturers of Peelclear.
- They are solely responsible for workmanship, installation quality, substrate evaluation, surface preparation, customer communication, customer disclosures, and removal procedures.
- They must comply with Peelclear system procedures, Controlled Documents, and warranty participation requirements.
- They must obtain the required Customer Acknowledgment and Release prior to any preparation or installation work.
- They must retain executed Customer Acknowledgment and Release records and provide them to Peelclear upon request.
- They must submit accurate and complete warranty registration information through the Warranty Portal.
- They may not make unauthorized promises, guarantees, warranties, or representations on behalf of Peelclear.
- They may not modify, expand, or contradict this Warranty.

Failure to comply with Installer Participation Requirements may result in denial of warranty eligibility, suspension of warranty registration privileges, or removal from the Peelclear Warranty Program.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the installer releases Peelclear from claims, losses, damages, liabilities, and expenses arising out of or relating to installer workmanship, preparation, installation, Removal, customer communication, invoices, estimates, representations, omissions, unauthorized promises, or failure to follow Peelclear requirements.

08 What Is Covered

This Warranty covers qualifying failures of the Peelclear paint system to maintain Product Integrity, adhesion, removability, and Protective Paint Function when such failure is caused by a verified Defect in the Product.

Covered qualifying failures may include:

- Delamination of the Peelclear System.
- Blistering of the Peelclear System.
- Adhesion failure of the Peelclear base coat or approved top coat.
- Peeling Edge Failure caused by a verified Defect in the Product.
- Premature Yellowing caused by Product degradation.
- Cracking or structural breakdown of the Product.
- Failure of the Product to maintain its Protective Paint Function due to a verified Defect.
- Other material failures that Peelclear confirms are caused by a verified Defect in the Product.

For purposes of this Warranty, covered failures must be caused by the Product itself and not by improper installation, improper surface preparation, incompatible materials, non-approved top coats, substrate instability, environmental contamination, improper maintenance, impact, abrasion, Removal activity, or other excluded causes.

The Original Owner bears the burden of demonstrating eligibility and evidence of a qualifying Product failure.

Peelclear will evaluate claims using a reasonable review of submitted evidence, photographs, inspection information, maintenance history, installer records, Product records, and available supporting documentation.

09 What Is Not Covered

This is a limited Product warranty. Except as expressly stated in this Warranty, Peelclear does not cover the following.

9.1 UNDERLYING SURFACE AND SUBSTRATE CONDITIONS

Although Peelclear warrants the Product's Protective Paint Function as expressly stated in this Warranty, Peelclear does not warrant the Underlying Surface itself.

This Warranty does not cover the condition, adhesion, stability, quality, repair history, cure state, or long-term performance of OEM paint, refinished paint, repainted panels, repaired panels, primer, wraps, vinyl, paint protection film, plastics, trim, prior coatings, or any other Underlying Surface.

This Warranty does not cover repainting, refinishing, restoring, repairing, replacing, or correcting any Underlying Surface, except to the limited extent required by applicable law.

9.2 REMOVAL-RELATED CONDITIONS

This Warranty does not cover:

- Damage caused by improper Removal.
- Damage caused by aggressive tools, chemicals, heat, solvents, or techniques used during Removal.
- Damage related to unstable, weakened, repainted, repaired, or previously refinished surfaces.
- Damage associated with non-OEM paint, prior refinishing, prior repairs, or unknown paint systems.
- Paint lifting, paint delamination, clear coat failure, primer failure, or surface dislodging caused by Underlying Surface instability or improper Removal.

A covered Product removability failure may be eligible for the remedies stated in this Warranty, but Peelclear does not guarantee damage-free Removal from every substrate or Underlying Surface.

9.3 APPEARANCE AND COSMETIC CONDITIONS

This Warranty does not cover:

- Minor texture variation.
- Orange peel.
- Gloss variation.
- Finish variation.
- Appearance dissatisfaction.
- Lighting or viewing angle differences.
- Color perception differences.
- Minor aging or wear over time.
- Cosmetic conditions that do not constitute a covered Defect.

No cosmetic or visual outcome is warranted except to the limited extent expressly stated for Premature Yellowing caused by Product degradation.

9.4 INSTALLATION, PREPARATION, AND WORKMANSHIP

This Warranty does not cover:

- Installer error.
- Faulty workmanship.
- Improper surface preparation.
- Contamination before, during, or after installation.
- Improper cure conditions.
- Application outside Peelclear specifications.
- Failure to follow Controlled Documents.
- Failure to inspect or evaluate substrate suitability.
- Installation over unsuitable or unstable Underlying Surfaces.

9.5 NON-APPROVED TOP COATS AND SYSTEM MODIFICATIONS

This Warranty does not cover any condition, failure, appearance concern, adhesion issue, yellowing, peeling, delamination, blistering, cracking, Removal issue, or Protective Paint Function issue caused by or related to the use of any non-Peelclear-approved top coat, coating, additive, reducer, chemical, modifier, or third-party component.

Use of non-approved materials may result in denial of coverage for the affected Treated Area.

9.6 WEAR, EXPOSURE, AND EXTERNAL EVENTS

This Warranty does not cover:

- Normal wear and tear.
- Road debris.
- Rock chips.
- Impact damage.
- Scratches caused by external objects.
- Abrasion.
- Vandalism.
- Accidents.
- Racing or track use.
- Off-road abuse.
- Commercial abuse.
- Industrial fallout.
- Fuel spills.
- Solvent exposure.
- Harsh chemicals.
- Wildfire ash.
- Marine salt exposure.
- Road salt damage.
- Bird droppings.
- Tree sap.
- Bug splatter.
- Water spotting.
- Improper washing.
- Automatic brush car washes.
- Pressure washing outside Peelclear care instructions.

Environmental contamination must be cleaned promptly in accordance with Peelclear aftercare instructions.

9.7 INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, AND THIRD-PARTY COSTS

This Warranty does not cover:

- Loss of use.
- Vehicle downtime.
- Rental vehicles.
- Lost revenue.
- Business interruption.
- Travel costs.
- Storage fees.
- Diminished value.
- Third-party claims.
- Attorneys fees.
- Punitive damages.
- Incidental damages.
- Consequential damages.

9.8 INSTALLER, DEALER, AND THIRD-PARTY REPRESENTATIONS

Certified Installers, dealers, shops, distributors, and service providers are independent businesses and are not employees, agents, franchisees, representatives, partners, or joint venturers of Peelclear.

Any installer promise, estimate, invoice, statement, marketing statement, service statement, or representation that is inconsistent with this Warranty is solely the responsibility of the installer or shop and does not bind Peelclear.

10 Surface Preservation and Removability

Peelclear is engineered as a removable, non-destructive paint system intended to support the preservation of Suitable Underlying Surfaces when properly installed, maintained, and removed.

However, surface preservation, removability, and final results may vary depending on:

- Surface condition.
- Repaint history.
- Prior repairs.
- Prior coatings.
- Paint age.
- Paint cure state.
- Surface contamination.
- Environmental exposure.
- Installation quality.
- Maintenance history.
- Removal procedures.
- Substrate instability.

Peelclear does not guarantee identical removability results across all vehicles, substrates, paint systems, or environmental conditions.

Peelclear warrants the Product's Protective Paint Function only as expressly stated in this Warranty and only for covered Defects in the Product.

11 Claim Process and Evidence Requirements

All claims must be submitted through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved claim process.

A claim must be submitted within thirty (30) days after the Original Owner first discovers the issue that is the basis of the claim. Claims submitted outside this window may be denied to the maximum extent permitted by law.

A valid claim may require:

- Proof of purchase.
- Installation invoice.
- Installation date.
- Installer information.
- Product system details.
- Photographs and video documentation.
- Maintenance records.
- Three-year warranty check-in history.
- Care compliance attestations.
- Copy of the signed Customer Acknowledgment and Release.
- Proof that the installer was certified or approved at the time of installation.
- Product samples, labels, packaging, batch information, or lot numbers where available.
- Any additional information reasonably requested by Peelclear.

No repairs, reapplication, Removal, refinishing, modification, aggressive cleaning, or other work may be performed on the affected area before claim review and written authorization by Peelclear, except where required for safety.

If the affected area is altered before written authorization, the claim may be denied unless Peelclear provides a written waiver.

The Original Owner and installer must preserve the affected area and provide reasonable access for inspection if requested.

Failure to preserve evidence, provide access, or submit requested documentation may result in denial of the claim.

12 Warranty Remedies

If Peelclear confirms a qualifying Defect covered by this Warranty, Peelclear may, at its reasonable discretion, provide one or more of the following remedies for the affected Treated Area:

- Replacement Product.
- Refund of Product amounts paid for the affected Treated Area.
- Approved labor reimbursement for authorized Removal and reapplication.
- Approved repair or reapplication procedures.

Labor reimbursement is available only when Peelclear approves the labor in writing before the work is performed.

Approved labor reimbursement is limited to reasonable labor directly related to authorized Removal and reapplication of the Peelclear Product in the affected Treated Area.

No labor, Removal, reapplication, repair, refinishing, repainting, service, or third-party cost is covered unless approved in writing by Peelclear before the work is performed.

Replacement Product does not extend or restart the Warranty term.

Related failures, repeated failures, or related conditions arising from the same installation, Product condition, or alleged Defect may be treated as one warranty claim by Peelclear.

All remedies are subject to the maximum liability limit stated in Section 13.

13 Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Peelclear's total liability under this Warranty shall not exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000 USD) per approved warranty claim for the affected Treated Area.

This maximum liability limit includes, without limitation:

- Replacement Product.
- Refunds.
- Approved labor reimbursement.
- Approved Removal costs.
- Approved reapplication costs.
- Approved repair procedures.
- Any other warranty remedy.

Under no circumstance shall Peelclear be liable for any amount exceeding the \$3,000 maximum warranty remedy cap.

Related claims, repeated claims, or multiple submissions arising from the same Product condition, installation, affected Treated Area, or alleged Defect may be treated as a single claim for purposes of the \$3,000 maximum warranty remedy cap.

Peelclear shall not be liable for repainting costs, refinishing costs, substrate restoration, vehicle repair, diminished value, loss of use, rental vehicles, business interruption, indirect damages, consequential damages, punitive damages, attorneys fees, or third-party claims.

These limitations apply even if any remedy fails of its essential purpose.

14 Disclaimer of Additional Warranties and No Performance Guarantees

Except as expressly stated in this Warranty, Peelclear makes no additional warranties or guarantees regarding:

- Cosmetic perfection.
- Identical appearance results.
- Identical removability results.
- Scratch prevention.
- Chip prevention.
- Impact prevention.
- Chemical resistance beyond Normal Automotive Use.
- Environmental resistance beyond Normal Automotive Use.
- Permanent preservation of finish.
- Permanent preservation of any Underlying Surface.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, any implied warranties are limited in duration to the term of this Limited Warranty or the shortest period permitted by applicable law.

Some jurisdictions do not allow limitations on implied warranties or exclusions of certain damages. These limitations apply only to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

15 No Unauthorized Representations fees

No installer, distributor, dealer, salesperson, representative, or third party is authorized to modify, expand, extend, or contradict this Warranty.

Only Peelclear may issue warranty determinations through the Warranty Portal or another Peelclear-approved written process.

Any verbal statement, marketing statement, estimate, invoice, sample, demonstration, or communication inconsistent with this Warranty does not modify this Warranty and does not bind Peelclear.

16 Controlled Documents and Governing Terms

This Warranty, together with applicable Controlled Documents, warranty registration records, Installer Participation Requirements, and Customer Acknowledgment and Release requirements, constitutes the complete warranty framework for the Product.

Peelclear may update warranty procedures, maintenance requirements, check-in requirements, claim requirements, installer participation procedures, and related warranty administration processes from time to time.

The current version of this Warranty and related warranty documents will be maintained through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved system.

In the event of a conflict between marketing materials, summaries, website content, sales communications, or informal statements and this Warranty, this Warranty controls.

If any provision of this Warranty is determined unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain enforceable to the maximum extent permitted by law.

18 Dispute Resolution and Class Action Waiver

Before initiating any arbitration, lawsuit, or other legal proceeding, the claimant must submit a notice of dispute through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved process and allow Peelclear thirty (30) days to inspect, evaluate, and attempt resolution.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, all disputes, claims, or controversies arising out of or relating to the Product, Warranty, Warranty Portal, warranty registration, warranty claim, installation, Removal, or related services shall be resolved on an individual basis.

Class actions, collective actions, representative actions, and private attorney general actions are not permitted to the maximum extent permitted by law.

If the Warranty Portal, Installer Participation Requirements, or applicable accepted terms include an arbitration agreement, the arbitration terms in that agreement govern eligible disputes.

19 Time Limitation for Claims

To the maximum extent permitted by law, any legal action or proceeding arising out of or relating to the Product, Warranty, warranty registration, or warranty claim must be filed within one (1) year after the claimant first discovers, or reasonably should have discovered, the facts giving rise to the claim.

Any claim not filed within this time may be permanently barred to the maximum extent permitted by law.

20. Warranty Portal and Installer Acceptance

By creating or using a Certified Installer account, accessing the Warranty Portal, submitting a warranty registration, or participating in the Peelclear Warranty Program, the installer acknowledges and agrees to the terms, conditions, exclusions, limitations, release requirements, customer acknowledgment requirements, and Installer Participation Requirements contained in this Warranty.

Installer further certifies that all future warranty submissions through the Warranty Portal will comply with Peelclear warranty procedures, including obtaining signed Customer Acknowledgment and Release documentation prior to any vehicle preparation, surface preparation, or installation work.

The Warranty Portal may require installer acceptance of this Warranty and related Installer Participation Requirements during account creation, certification, or warranty submission.

Peelclear may retain acceptance records, including installer account information, timestamp, IP address if available, accepted document version, warranty registration ID, VIN or vehicle identifier, and other submission records.

21 Waiver and Severability

No failure or delay by Peelclear in exercising any right under this Warranty operates as a waiver of that right.

If any provision of this Warranty is held invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in full force and effect to the maximum extent permitted by law.

22 Acceptance

By participating in the Peelclear Warranty Program, creating or using a Certified Installer account, submitting a warranty registration, accepting warranty coverage, or making a claim under this Warranty, the applicable installer and Original Owner acknowledge and agree to the terms, conditions, exclusions, limitations, maintenance obligations, release requirements, and claim procedures contained in this Warranty.

This Warranty is effective only when all eligibility requirements are satisfied and the warranty registration is properly submitted through the Warranty Portal or other Peelclear-approved process.
