Section 1. The Mayor and Director of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to apply for grant funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Keystone Communities Grant program, to provide funding for the purchase of play equipment in Phillips Park. The grant proposal includes a request of THIRTY THOUSAND (\$30,000.00) DOLLARS.
