WHEREAS, the Grand Marshal this year is John Banaszak. Mr. Banaszak played for the Pittsburgh Steelers from 1975 to 1981 and is a three-time Super Bowl champion. He served in the United States Marine Corps and inducted into the Marine Corps Sports Hall of Fame in 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Federation continues to educate the residents of the City of Pittsburgh on the importance of recognizing our veterans and all they have sacrificed, not only for the City of Pittsburgh, but also our nation; and
