Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of Office of Management and Budget, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement/Agreements, in the form approved by the City Solicitor with the Urban League of Pittsburgh, for the implementation/administration of the Housing Counseling program, and related costs, in the amount not to exceed \$100,000.00-One Hundred Thousand Dollars, chargeable and payable from the following account:
