Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of the Department of Public Safety to enter into a Professional Services Agreement or Agreements with Humane Animal Rescue of Pittsburgh for services related to the City's Spay and Neuter Program for Community Cats, at a total cost not to exceed ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$105,000.00) over three years.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement or Agreements with Humane Animal Rescue of Pittsburgh for implementation of the City's Spay and Neuter Program for Community Cats, whereby the City shall reimburse said private vendors for spay and neuter services performed upon community cats living in colonies within City limits and cared for by registered City-resident trappers, at a total cost not to exceed ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$105,000.00) over three years, and providing for the payment of the costs thereof, chargeable to and payable from the following account codes, subject to the appropriation of funds by City Council in future budget years:
