Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an Agreement or amendments thereto, with the President and Fellows of Harvard College acting through the Taubman Center for State and Local Government at the Harvard Kennedy School to receive technical assistance to use procurement as a lever for inclusive workforce development, job quality, and local economic empowerment at no cost to the City.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement or amendments thereto, with the President and Fellows of Harvard College acting through the Taubman Center for State and Local Government at the Harvard Kennedy School to receive technical assistance to use procurement as a lever for inclusive workforce development, job quality, and local economic empowerment to support implementation of the Pittsburgh Good Job Principles in City contracting and in furtherance of the goals of City Code Chapter 177A.02.

Section 2. Said agreement(s) shall be approved by the City Solicitor as to form.
