Resolution authorizing the Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Department of Public Safety to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with Allegheny County and the United States Department of Justice for the purpose of receiving grant funds from the 2024 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant in the amount not to exceed FIFTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN (\$51,614.00) dollars to purchase a real-time asset management technology platform.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Department of Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with Allegheny County and the United States Department of Justice for the purpose of receiving grant funds in an amount not to exceed FIFTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN (\$51,614.00) dollars to purchase a real-time asset management technology platform. Monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund account 2329400510.45703.00.

Section 2. The Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget and the Director of the Department of Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are further authorized to follow regular procurement processes to make all legitimate expenditures required by said Agreement(s) as outlined in Section 1. Said grant expenditures shall not exceed FIFTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN

(\$51,614.00) dollars, chargeable to and payable from the appropriate expense account in the Grant Trust Fund, job number 2329400510.
