Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Resolution No. 803 of 2024, entitled “Resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Pittsburgh, and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to apply for a grant from Pennsylvania Department of Economic Development’s Multimodal Transportation Fund for the Penn Avenue Lighting project. The grant proposal includes an ask of FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY SIX DOLLARS (\$461,856.00) dollars for this stated purpose.” is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, the Director of the office of Management and Budget and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure are authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with the Pennsylvania Department of Economic Development’s Multimodal Transportation Fund for the AI Corridor

Penn Avenue Lighting Project in the amount not to exceed of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$450,000.00) dollars. Monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into Grants Trust Fund account 6029400514.455247.00.

Section 2. The Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure are further authorized to follow regular procurement processes to make all legitimate expenditures required by said Agreement(s) as outlined in Section 1. Said expenditures shall not exceed FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$450,000.00) dollars, chargeable to and payable from the appropriate expense account in the Grants Trust Fund, job number 6029400514.
