Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of Public Safety to enter on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh into a professional services agreement or agreements with RollKall Technologies, LLC, for a web-based secondary employment scheduling system in an amount not-to-exceed EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS AND TWELVE CENTS (\$85,392.12) over five years.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to enter on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh into a five-year professional services agreement or agreements with RollKall Technologies, LLC for a web-based secondary employment scheduling system and related support services in which Public Safety employees can bid on secondary employment jobs, which are paid by secondary employers approved by Public Safety, in an amount not-to-exceed EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS AND TWELVE CENTS (\$85,392.12) over five years.

Section 2. Funds for said agreement or agreements shall be chargeable and payable from the following chart of accounts subject to available appropriations, broken down by budget year and corresponding dollar amount:
