Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement of Agreements with North Star Leadership LLC, for Police supervisor development and training, at a total cost not to exceed TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00), over one year.
