Resolution amending Resolution No. 353 of 2025, which authorized a Professional Service Agreement(s) and or Contract(s) with Malady & Wooten, Inc. for consulting services for state government affairs and legislative services, by extending the term through the second quarter of 2026, and increasing the approved amount by Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$16,500) for a new total cost not to exceed Six Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$627,000) over ten (10) years and three (3) months.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Management & Budget, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an amended Professional Services Agreement(s) and/or Contract (s) with Malady & Wooten, Inc. for consulting services for state government affairs and legislative services at a cost not to exceed Six Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$627,000) over ten (10) years and three (3) months.

Section 2. The City Controller shall encumber funds for the annual contract, subject to the amount of funds to be appropriated by City Council in respective budget year from the following chart account:
