Resolution authorizing the Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Department of City Planning to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with the Open Space Institute for the purpose of receiving grant funds in the amount not to exceed TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000.00) dollars to acquire privately owned tax-delinquent land to improve connectivity of our greenways.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Department of City Planning are authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with the Open Space Institute for the purpose of receiving grant funds in the amount not to exceed TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000.00) dollars to acquire privately owned tax-delinquent land to improve connectivity of our greenways. Monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund account 1129400542.48311.00.

Section 2. The Mayor, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Department of City Planning, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are further authorized to follow regular procurement processes to make all legitimate expenditures required by said Agreement(s) as outlined in Section 1. Said grants expenditures shall not exceed TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000.00) dollars, chargeable to and payable from the appropriate expense account in the Grants Trust Fund, job number 1129400542.
