

DSCSA: Global Location Numbers and Compliance Data Preferences June 2023

Cardinal Health remains committed to providing the latest information as we prepare for Pharmaceutical Tracing requirements that take effect in November 2023.

Global Location Number (GLN) Requirement

Customers will need a GLN to receive DSCSA serialized data in November. Customers who do not obtain a GLN will be out of compliance, *and we will be unable to transact business or ship products to you.*

Customers with 9 or more locations must complete the **Cardinal Health DSCSA GLN Number Data Collection form** by **August 1, 2023**. *Use the QR code to access the form*.

Customers with fewer than 9 locations will receive GLNs from a Cardinal Health representative.

GLNs will appear on customer invoices later this summer. Additional information about GLNs, including an updated FAQ, is available on our Pharmaceutical Tracing website.

DSCSA Compliance Data Preferences

We will begin electronically tracking products at the individual package level on November 27, 2023. Customers have two options for receiving DSCSA serialized transaction data:

- 1. Cardinal Health Web Portal (Track and Trace Reporting): We will make necessary updates to our Track and Trace Reporting to provide enhanced security requirements down to the item level. Later this summer, we will provide additional details and an updated user guide for the new report. If you choose this option, no action is needed from you at this time. You will continue to have access to the existing report for items purchased before November 27, 2023.
- EPCIS Solution Provider: If you plan to receive data via EPCIS and haven't completed the data collection form, please complete the Cardinal Health DSCSA EPCIS Solution Provider Information (3rd Party vendors) form by August 1, 2023. We will reach out later this summer to schedule testing. Use the QR code to access the form.
