CHARACTERISTICS OF DHANISHTA/AVITTAM NAKSHATRAM





The TWENTY THIRD of 27 is the nakshatra of DHANISHTA also known as AVITTAM in tamil. It belongs to the Capricorn - Aquarius zodiac sign. It spreads from 293 degrees 20 minutes to 300 degrees 0 minutes of Capricorn to 300 degrees 0 min to 306 degrees 40 min of Aquarius.

Dhanishta nakshatra is composed of four stars in the constellation of Delphini. In the sky, the stars Alpha, Beta, Gamma, and Delta Delphini form the head of a dolphin.

Sanskrit Name: धनिष्ठा (Dhanishta) comes from the Sanskrit words धन (wealth) and तिष्ठति (reside). One meaning of Dhanishta is "the rich one," indicating good fortune, resilience, and a strong character.

SRI ANANTAPADMANABHA SWAMY



Om Namo Narayanaya. Om Namo Bhagavate Vasudevaya"

Anantha means the infinite and endless. **Anantha** Padmanabha is Lord Vishnu reclining on the snake Anantha in Anantha Shavana posture and is in Yoga nidra (Cosmic Slumber). This posture of Lord Vishnu resembles his concern and thoughts about the Universe and its prosperity.

Vishnu is the Supreme God of Vaishnavism and one of the three supreme deities (Trimurti) of Hinduism. He is also known as Narayana and Hari. He is conceived as "the Preserver or the Protector" within the Trimurti, the Hindu Trinity of the divinity.

A complex character, Vishnu is the Preserver and guardian of men (Narayana), he protects the order of things (dharma) and, when necessary, he appears on earth in various incarnations or avatars to fight demons and fierce creatures and so maintain cosmic harmony.

Vishnu represents Sattvaguna and is the centripetal force as it were, responsible for sustenance, protection and maintenance of the created universe.

Etymologically speaking, the word 'Vishnu' means 'one who pervades, one who has entered into everything.' So, he is the transcendent as well the immanent reality of the universe. He is the inner cause and power by which things exist.

Shri Anantha Padmanabhaswamy temple is located in the East fort at Pazhavangadi of Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala. This is the temple of Lord Shri Vishnu which is an ancient structure that was even visited by Balarama, according to Srimad Bhagavatam, etc. According to the ancient scriptures, it was believed to be built over 5000 years ago but has no perfect pieces of evidence.

Sahasraa seersham devam viswaaksham viswaasambhuvam Viswam naaraayanam devam aksharam paramam padam This universe is the Eternal Being (Narayana), the imperishable, the supreme, the goal, multi-headed and multi-eyed (i.e., omnipresent and omniscient), the resplendent, the source of

- 1. The sacred temple that resonates with the AVITTAM nakshatra is Sri Sri Pushpavalli Samedha Sri Brahma Gnanpureeswarar Temple located in a village called Korukkai near Kumbakonam in TamilNadu.
- Those born under this star should visit this temple as frequently as possible.

The grace of Sri Brahma Gnanpureeswarar has the ability to assist children with concentration and success in their education. it is auspicious to offer a garland, betel leaves, nuts, turmeric, or a saree to poor women at the temple. The blessings of Lord Shiva, Goddess Parvati and Nandhi bring enormous benefits to those who visit this temple. Lord Shiva can remove financial obstacles and is also helpful for relationship difficulties. It is especially beneficial to visit Korukkai when Pradosham occurs on a Saturday. It is beneficial to visit on Avani Avittam day for spiritual growth.




AVITTAM natives, your incense is made with the herb Kejari as prescribed by the Vedas.
