


CHARACTERISTICS OF MRIGASIRA/MRIGASEERSHAM NAKSHATRAM





The FIFTH of 27 is the nakshatra of MRIGASIRA also called as Mrigaseersham in Tamil. It belongs to the Taurus –Gemini zodiac sign. It spreads from 53°20' to 60° 00 Taurus & 60° 00 to 66°40' Gemini.

In the night sky, Mrigasira nakshatra consists of four stars located in the constellation of Orion: Bellatrix (Gamma-Orionis), Pi2, Pi3, and Pi4-Orionis. Bellatrix is the brightest of these stars and is located on the right shoulder of Orion. These stars form the shape of a deer's head, which is the symbol of Mrigasira.

<u>Sanskrit Name:</u> Mrgaśira (मृगशिर) a composite of two Sanskrit words, mrga (मृग) meaning deer and śira (शिर) meaning head or precisely, the top of the head.

Among the supreme deities of the Hindu pantheon, Lord Shiva_is known to be the most remarkable. Shiva is frequently alluded to as the "destroyer".

He frees a body of its deficiencies and makes it deserving of accomplishing moksha. It is he who is responsible for obliteration on the grounds that if the 'old' doesn't perish, the 'new' wouldn't have the option to take birth.

SRI CHANDRACHUDESWAR: It means the Lord who wars the moon on his head. The different phases of the moon represent the different time dimension which further leads to the lunar cycle in a calendar. Time which is the base of the physical existence and Moon over the head of Shiva symbolizes Shiva as <u>Mahakaal</u> who is beyond the physical aspect of life.

1)Moon over Shiva's head represents the cycle of birth and death.

2)The full moon represents the dominant state of the person.

3)Crescent over Shiva's head helps peoples to personified their growth. 4)Waning moon assures you that Shiva is there for you during hard times. 5)Moon over Lord Shiva's head depicts him as Pashupati.

AumTatpurushaaya Vidvamahe Mahadevaaya Dheemahi Thanno Rudra Prachodayath



<u>Maha Mrityunjaya Mantra</u>


Om Tryambakam Yajamahe Sugandhim Pushti-Vardhanam Urvarukamiva Bandhanan Mrityormukshiya Mamritat

Benefits of Performing Pooja MRIGASEERSHAM Nakshatra Devatas



- 1. The sacred temple that resonates with the Rohini nakshatra is Sri Aadhi Narayana PerumalTemple located in village of Ennkann, near Koradacheri in Tamil Nadu, India.
- 2. Those born under this star should visit this temple as frequently as possible.

3. It is believed that the auspicious energy of this temple can assist people with matters concerning their profession or job. It is beneficial to perform abhishekham on Mrigashira days, Vishnupati days, Wednesdays and Saturdays.

4.Also, offering a sweet drink to the poor will help overcome anxiety and worry. It is advantageous to walk around this sacred shrine while carrying a ghee lamp. This is a remedy for relieving conflicts with enemies. People can also make an offering of sweet rice, milk and nuts to the poor to improve their reputation. And finally, anointing Garuda, the sacred bird, with butter along with sandalwood past for Vishnu is favorable for prosperity and health.




Mrigasira natives, your incense is made with the herb Ebony as prescribed by the Vedas.
