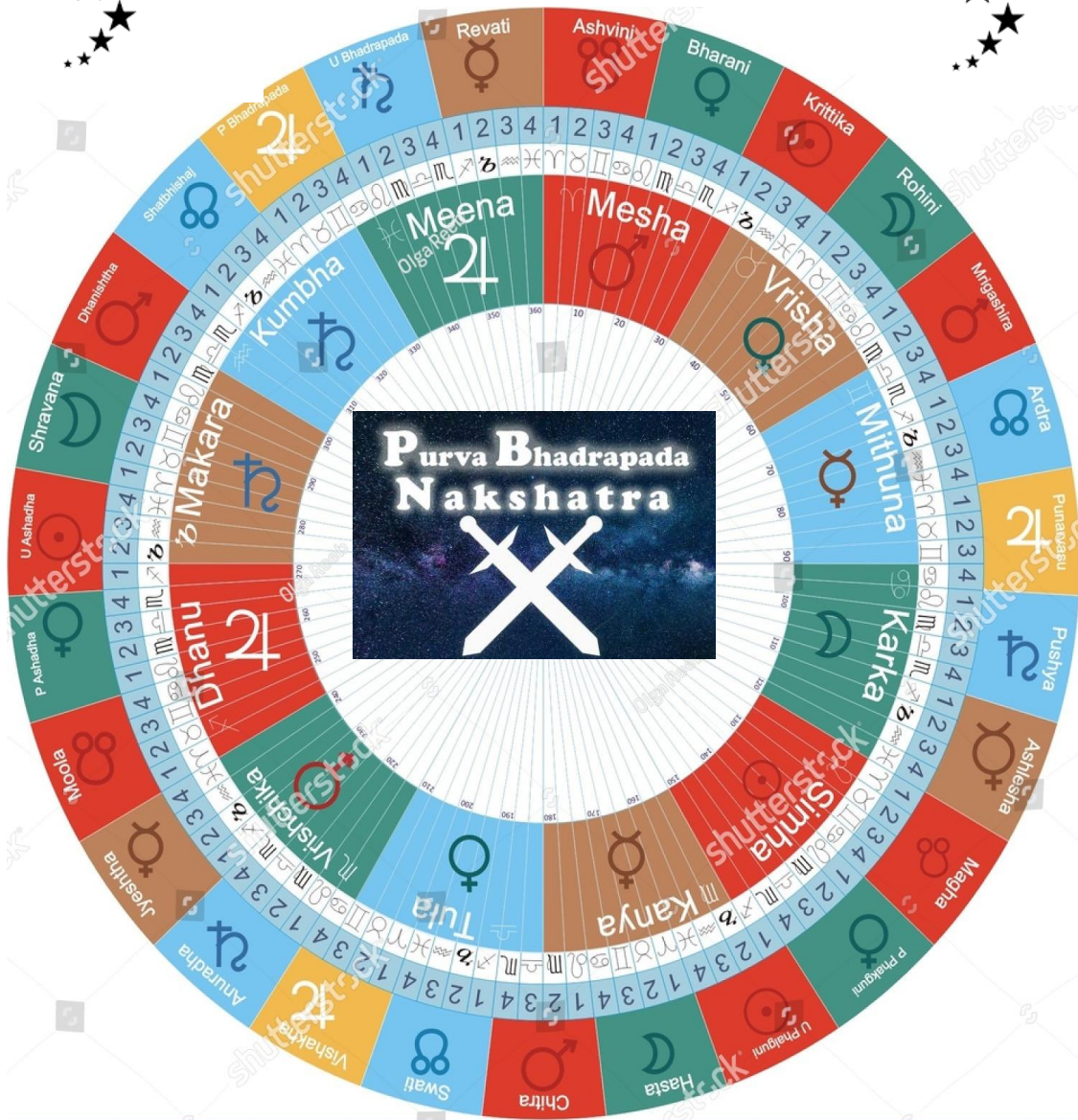

CHARACTERISTICS OF PURVABHADRAPADA/POORATATHI NAKSHATRAM



The **TWENTY FIFTH** of 27 is the nakshatra of **PURVABHADRAPADA** also known as **POORATATHI** in tamil. It belongs to the **Aquarius - Pisces zodiac sign**. It spreads from **320 degrees 0 minutes to 330 degrees 0 minutes of Aquarius to 330 degrees 0 min to 333 degrees 20 min Pisces**.

The nakshatra Purvabhadrapada is located in the constellation Peegasus, the winged horse. It is comprised of the two stars, Markab (alpha Pegas) and Scheat (beta Pegasi).

Sanskrit Name: पूर्वभाद्रपदा (Purva-bhadrapada) comes from the Sanskrit words पूर्व (early) and भद्र (blessed). One meaning of Purva-bhadrapada is “the early blessed one,” indicating enthusiasm, good fortune, and happiness..

DEITY ASSOCIATED WITH THE NAKSHATRAM :
SRI EKA BHADRAR (Lord Shiva as cosmic pillar(light) of the universe)

SRI SHIVAYA NAMAH

Among the supreme deities of the Hindu pantheon, Lord Shiva is known to be the most remarkable. Shiva is frequently alluded to as the "destroyer".

He frees a body of its deficiencies and makes it deserving of accomplishing moksha. It is he who is responsible for obliteration on the grounds that if the 'old' doesn't perish, the 'new' wouldn't have the option to take birth.

Eka bhadrar : Ekabhadrar represents the Axis Mundi (cosmic pillar of the universe) and portrays Shiva as the Supreme Lord, from whom Vishnu and Brahma originate.

Ekabhadrar is often accompanied by ascetic attendants, whose presence emphasizes his connection to severe penance.

Panchakshari Shiva Mantra – ‘Om Namah Shivaya’

Rudra Mantra – ‘Om Namo Bhagwate Rudraaya’

Shiva Gayatri Mantra

AumTatpurushaaya Vidvamahe
Mahadevaaya Dheemahi
Thanno Rudra Prachodayath

Meaning: Let us invoke the superlative (-tath) male (-purusha) and omniscient lord (-vidvamahe). Let us meditate and focus upon (-dheemahi) the supreme (-maha) lord (-devaaya). Let us ask Shiva (-rudra) to provide us inspiration and guidance (-prachodayaat) in our spiritual journeys.

Maha Mrityunjaya Mantra

Om Tryambakam Yajamahe
Sugandhim Pushti-Vardhanam
Urvarukamiva Bandhanan
Mrityormukshiya Mamritat||

Meaning :We concentrate on our third eye which lies behind the two eyes and this gives us the power to feel you and by this we feel happy, satisfied and peace in life. We know immortality is not possible but some extension can be given to our death by your powers Lord Shiva.

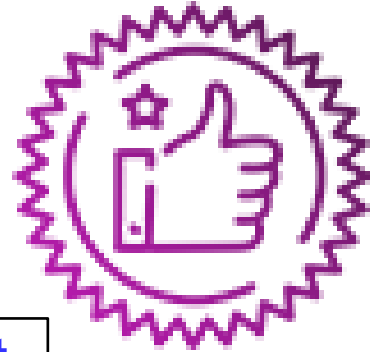

Indication: Scorching or Burning pair



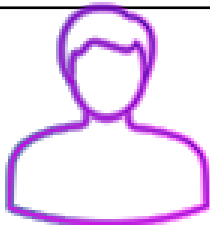

Benefits of Performing Pooja **POORATATHI**_Nakshatra Devatas



- 1. The sacred temple that resonates with the Pooratathi nakshatra is Sri Sri Kamakshi Samedha Tiru Aaneswarar Temple located in a village called Renganathapuram, which is near Tirukkattuppalli in TamilNadu.**
- 2. Those born under this star should visit this temple as frequently as possible.**

3. Those people born under Purvabhadra nakshatra can worship at this shrine for seven days and anoint the statues with plantains, honey, ghee, sugar, and offer seven garlands. This will eliminate the karmic afflictions of seven lifetimes. Also, it is recommended to donate seven colored garments at this temple to remove ancestral curses.

4. Those who are born under a different star but wish to visit this temple will also benefit. They may worship at this sacred shrine continuously for seven days. Meditation, contemplation and yoga performed at this temple will produce benefic effects and assist with career problems.



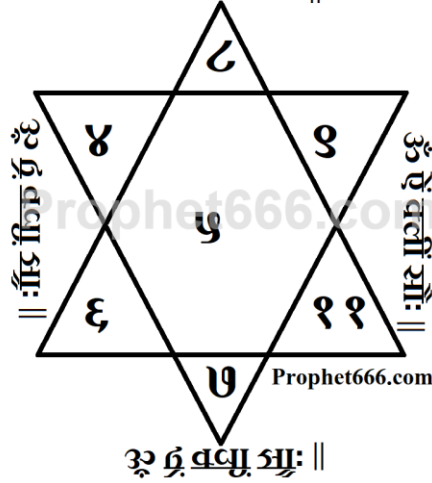
