

CHARACTERISTICS OF REVATHY NAKSHATRAM



The TWENTY SEVENTH of 27 is the nakshatra of REVATHY and the final nakshatram. It belongs to the Pisces zodiac sign. It spreads from 346 degrees 40 minutes to 360 degrees 0 minutes of Pisces.

Revati is a group of stars in the constellation Pisces. The brightest of the group is Zeta Piscium.

Sanskrit Name: रेवती (Revati) comes from the Sanskrit word रेवत् (wealth and prosperity). Revati indicates a person who is blessed, beautiful, and prosperous.

SRI ARANGANATHAN



Om Namo Narayanaya. Om Namo Bhagavate Vasudevaya"

RANGANATHA in Sanskrit means "leader of the place of assembly", coined from the two Sanskrit words ranga (place) and natha (lord or leader). The deity is a resting form of Vishnu, recumbent on the great form of Adishesha, the king of the serpents in the sea of cosmic dissolution. This is the form in which he is open to listening to all of his devotees' woes, and blesses them

Vishnu is the Supreme God of Vaishnavism and one of the three supreme deities (Trimurti) of Hinduism. He is also known as Narayana and Hari. He is conceived as "the Preserver or the Protector" within the Trimurti, the Hindu Trinity of the divinity.

A complex character, Vishnu is the Preserver and guardian of men (Narayana), he protects the order of things (dharma) and, when necessary, he appears on earth in various incarnations or avatars to fight demons and fierce creatures and so maintain cosmic harmony.


Vishnu represents Sattvaguna and is the centripetal force as it were, responsible for sustenance, protection and maintenance of the created universe.


Etymologically speaking, the word 'Vishnu' means 'one who pervades, one who has entered into everything.' So, he is the transcendent as well the immanent reality of the universe. He is the inner cause and power by which things exist.

Lord Vishnu is worshipped as Ranganatha in the southern part of India. Thiruvarangam is a largest functioning Hindu temple dedicated to Ranganatha, a reclining form of Vishnu, standing tall in Srirangam, Tiruchirapalli, Tamil Nadu. Constructed in the Dravidian Architecture, this temple is glorified by Alvars in their Divya Prabhanda and has the unique distinction of not only being the foremost among the 108 Divya Desams dedicated to Lord Vishnu.

Benefits of Performing Pooja REVATHY_Nakshatra Devatas



- 1. The sacred temple that resonates with the Revathy nakshatra is Sri Karunaakakravalli Samedha Sri Kailasa Nather Temple located in a village called Karukudi, near Thaathaiyaangar in TamilNadu.
- 2. Those born under this star should visit this temple as frequently as possible.

3. At Karukudi Temple, the fertility of Lord Shiva is manifested in the energy of the sky. It is auspicious to connect with the divine energies at this temple when Revati star day occurs on a Sunday. This temple has abundant herbs with healing properties used to treat water related diseases.


The energy of this temple also produces the ability to heal eye related illnesses. On Revati day, abhishekhams are performed with 64 types of holy water, riches and fruits and offering white articles of clothing or food. This offering removes any concerns related to one's ancestry.



Revathy natives, your incense is made with the herb Indian Butter Tree as prescribed by the Vedas. Burning one of these pillars is like performing a mini fire ritual for that particular star formation.
