

CHARACTERISTICS OF VISHAKHA/VISAGAM NAKSHATRAM





The Sixteenth of 27 is the nakshatra of Vishakha also called as Visagam in Tamil. It belongs to the Libra -Scorpio zodiac sign. It spreads from 200 degrees 0 minutes to 200 degrees 10 minutes of Libra and 210 degrees 0 min to 213 degrees, 20 min of Scorpio. In the night sky, Vishaka nakshatra consists of four stars in the constellation of Libra: Alpha, Beta, Gamma, and Iota Librae. These stars form a "forked branch" and can be seen under the bright star Spica.

Sanskrit Name: विशाखा (Vishakha) comes from the Sanskrit words वि (divided) and शाखा (branch). One meaning of Vishakha is "the branched one," indicating intelligence, vitality, and many talents. DEITY ASSOCIATED WITH THE NAKSHATRAM : SRI MURUGAN

Meaning: Adoration to Lord Kartikeya, who is also known as Skanda. He is the one who holds the staff of intelligence, and holds the beautiful beloved Goddess Vallii. He is the enchanter of the mind of Goddess Devasena. I offer adorations repeatedly to that Divine Kartikeya.

Muruga, also known as Subramanya, Karthikeya, Shanmuga or Skanda, is the son of Lord Shiva and his consort, Goddess Parvati.

He is a unique Godhead, who is a rare combination of matchless valor and supreme, divine intelligence. He remains as the core of all the divine energies and is believed to lead one towards spiritual evolution.


Muruga is regarded as a Tamil God and is widely worshipped all over the state.

Lord Muruga is usually depicted as a youthful god with a charming personality, dressed as a warrior and holding his weapon Vel (lance) in his hand.

Sometimes, he is shown with six faces and 12 hands, carrying different weapons, which include sword, mace, javelin, discus, bow, etc. His mount peacock and a snake always accompany him. At times, he is also depicted along with his two consorts – Deivanai and Valli..

Benefits of Performing Pooja VISAGAM Nakshatra Devatas



1. The sacred temple that resonates with the Visagam nakshatra is Sri Tirumalai Murugan Koil located in a village called Sengottai in Tirunelveli Tamil Nadu,.

2.Those born under this star should visit this temple as frequently as possible.

3.T irumalai Murugan Koil contains powerful energies with the capacity to cure diseases. There are rare medicinal herbs available at this temple. One must first rinse in the pool at Tirumalai and then walk around the temple with the oil lamp. This offering produces thirty-two types of healing energy.

4. Those people born under Vishakha nakshatra should visit this temple and present an offering of light to Lord Muruga. Tirumalai has special light rays that form a powerful energy called Vishakha Jothi. This energy is contained within the Vishakha star. Offering tarpanam here will bring blessings to your ancestors.




Visakha natives, your incense is made with the herb Wood Apple as prescribed by the Vedas.
