



Petrokimia Gresik Lestari Bumi ENCOURAGE THE CREATION OF A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT IN EIGHT VILLAGES AROUND THE COMPANY

Still in the excitement of the company's 50th Anniversary as well as welcoming the 77th Anniversary of the Republic of Indonesia, Petrokimia Gresik invites people from 8 villages around the company to care about environmental health through the **Petrokimia Gresik Lestari Bumi** program. The activity was packaged through waste diet training and a village hygiene competition, whose awarding ceremony was held on Friday (5/7) in Gresik, East Java.

President Director of Petrokimia Gresik, Dwi Satriyo Annurogo, after handing over the award said that, as part of the SOE, Petrokimia Gresik has a responsibility as a development agent who is not only profit-oriented and the company's performance, but also encourages the creation of community welfare, especially in the environment around the company.

"The welfare of the community is inseparable from the health of the environment. Therefore, we have a high commitment to programs that encourage the creation of environmental health, one of which is the Petrokimia Gresik Lestari Bumi program," said Dwi Satriyo.

Through waste diet training, 80 driving figures from eight villages / kelurahan around the company were equipped with information related to types of waste, clean and healthy lifestyle materials, how to properly dispose of residual medicines and masks, diseases that can be transmitted through waste and animals, strategies to reduce family waste, viticulture as an example of urban farming, and regional regulations, sanitation, and spatial planning.

Furthermore, the village hygiene competition is a stimulus to implement the material that has been obtained. In its judging, Petrokimia Gresik involved several experts in their fields, including representatives of the Gresik Regency Environmental Service (DLH), Petrokimia Gresik Hospital (RSPG), East Java Environmental Ambassadors, to the company's internal jury.

The first place in the village cleaning competition won by Sukorame Village; Second Place in Kelurahan Ngipik, and Third Place in Kroman Village. Each winner received a cleaning allowance of Rp10 million, Rp7.5 million, and Rp5 million. Not only that, five other villages that were participants also received a cleaning allowance of 3 million each, including Karangpoh, Lumpur, Tlogopojok, Karangturi, and Roomo Villages.

Sukorame Village Head, Uman Iswahyudi after receiving the First Place award revealed that the Petrokimia Gresik Lestari Bumi program was able to change the environment in Sukorame Village, from originally arid to more beautiful, clean, and cool.

"Because of this program, people in Sukorame are encouraged to be more compact in terms of environmental health and hygiene. Hopefully, what Sukorame did can inspire the lain area in creating a clean and healthy environment," he said.

In addition to creating a healthy environment, Petrokimia Gresik also seeks to improve the degree of public health through a Healthy Lifestyle (PHS). This effort was realized by providing door prize assistance as well as operational funds for the implementation of healthy roads in the eight villages, each worth IDR 15 million.



"Intact health is created from a healthy environment and the implementation of a healthy lifestyle of the community so that it is comprehensive and supports each other. With a complete degree of health, the hope is to be able to increase the productivity and welfare of families around the company. This is the estuary or the purpose of the programs we roll out," said Dwi Satriyo.
