

HEALTHY VILLAGE OF PETROKIMIA GRESIK REACHES 13 PERCENT OF THE POPULATION AS BENEFICIARIES

Petrokimia Gresik is an Agroindustry Solution company and member of the <u>Pupuk Indonesia</u> holding company, has launched its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program "Kampung Sehat 2021" as well as commemorating "10 Years of a Healthy Village," in Gresik, Wednesday (17/3).

President Director of Petrokimia Gresik, Dwi Satriyo Annurogo, revealed that during this decade there were 179,394 beneficiaries of the Petrokimia Gresik Healthy Village program during 2011 to 2020, with a total budget of IDR 13.4 billion. The number of beneficiaries is around 13.8 percent of the total population of Gresik Regency which reaches more than 1.3 million.

"*Alhamdulillah*, this program is beneficial for the health of the community around the company. We will continue to align this CSR activity with the Gresik Regency Government program so that more beneficiaries can be benefited," said Dwi Satriyo.

The Healthy Village program collaborates with PT Petro Graha Medika and appointed Grha Husada Hospital as the operator for the eight villages around the company, namely Village of Roomo, Tlogopojok, Lumpur, Kroman, Karangturi, Karangpoh, Sukorame, and Ngipik.

Dwi Satriyo further explained that the Healthy Village program formulation was carried out with the Gresik District Health Office, Fishermen Health Center, Industrial, Alun-alun Community Health Center, Sukomulyo Health Center, Village Heads around the company, as well as input from the community around the company as program recipients.

From 2011 to 2017, the Healthy Village program still focuses on health activities curative with programs for providing basic health services such as free medical treatment, circumcision, cataract surgery, fogging and various other activities.

"In 2018, innovations began to be carried out with a focus on promotion and preventive Health activities, as well as solving basic health problems in society in line with the ideals of achieving Sustainable Development Goals 3 (SDGs 3): Good Health and Well Being," he said.

For a full year, Petrokimia Gresik educates the public about various information on disease prevention and emergency management at home. Then from 2019 to the present the program formulation refers to Healthy Family Indicators and Clean and Healthy Lifestyle.

"In 2021, we will roll out Healthy Village again with a CSR budget allocation of Rp1.4 billion with a target beneficiary of 20 thousand people," he said.



On the same occasion, the Regent of Gresik, Fandi Akhmad Yani, revealed that Petrokimia Gresik has become smarter, because since 10 years ago it has initiated the Healthy Village program.

For this reason, he hopes that this program can continue to run and be aligned with local government program, so that the results are more optimal. According to him, regional progress is not only measured by infrastructure development, but also collaboration with all elements in Gresik, including corporations such as Petrokimia Gresik.

"Covid-19 is still around us, and Gresik is still in the orange zone. I am sure that with the collaboration between the Regional Government and Petrokimia Gresik through the Healthy Village program, the number of Covid-19 in Gresik can be immediately suppressed," he said.

Dambaan Village

One of the optimizations of the Healthy Village program in the midst of this pandemic was carried out through the "Covid-19 Free *Dambaan* Village" competition for the eight villages/wards around the company. According to Dwi Satriyo, this activity is in line with Petrokimia Gresik's duties as the coordinator of the East Java SOE Covid-19 Response Task Force.

The winners of the "*Dambaan* Village" competition, among others, won 1st place was Village Sukorame, 2nd place was Tlogopojok Village, and 3rd place was Kroman Village.

"We hope that *Dambaan* Village can be an inspiration for other villages and sub-districts in Gresik Regency in preventing the transmission of Covid-19," said Dwi Satriyo.

Meanwhile, the Head of Sukorame Urban Village, Rofik Udin Efendi, revealed that this program has been able to motivate Sukorame residents to implement health protocols to prevent Covid-19 contagion.

"With this program, our residents actively remind each other if there are family, neighbors or friends who do not implement proper health protocols. This is our effort preventing the spread of Covid-19," said Rofik.

He hopes that the reach of this program will be expanded. Because this program is proven to be able to motivate the public in implementing health protocols, so that it can reduce the risk of Covid-19 contagion in the community.
