1	Reading Comprehension	7	These seven lessons guide your class through the whole story of 'Skellig' from beginning to end. The children will develop various reading skills as they read and/or listen to the story from start to finish.
2	Narrative	4	These four lessons guide your class through the ideas, planning, writing and evaluating stages of creating their own prequels or sequels to 'Skellig'.
3	Poetry	3	These three lessons give your class the opportunity to explore in more depth the many references to William Blake and his poetry that appear in 'Skellig'.
4	Debate	2	These two lessons encourage your children to develop their spoken language skills as they prepare for, and take part in, a debate about homeschooling, inspired by the character of Mina, who is home-educated by her mother.
5	Diary Entries	4	These four lessons will show your class how to write an effective and engaging diary entry as a character from 'Skellig', focusing on their choice and use of language.
