Preparation for the event. Please follow the broad checklist:

- Invites
- Mobilisation of the participants
- Spokesperson
- Banner or Placards (Designs will be provided)
- Snacks (if any)
- Social Media updates
- Petition signing
- Procure and save bills / receipts for every expense

During the event:

- Brief talk about Greenpeace India and its campaigns
- Green Charter
- Discuss local environmental issues
- Activity (Photo Op or artistics performance)
- Petition Signing
- Snacks break (if any)
- Social Media includes Facebook live, posts and tweets tagging Greenpeace India. A blog about the event is most welcome

DO'S AND DON'TS

It is a non-political event, we do not recommend in any way to vote for any political party.

The topic of discussion should be strictly limited to Green Charter and Environmental issues, local or national.

Always be in touch with the Public Engagement Campaigner for any kind of information and support.

Procure necessary permissions with the relevant authority for hosting an event.

Do not use plastics of any kind in the event, likewise no-smoking.

You are free to use your own group's banners provided it is non-political.

Do inform the Public Engagement Campaigner at least 7 days in advance about the event.

The photos you take should be of good quality, with faces and banner or placard messages clearly visible.
