19 years after the First-in-Man TAVI case performed by our team in Rouen on April 2002, the procedure is incredibly expanding. Significant technological advances and simplified strategies led to an explosion of TAVI with about 1 000 000 cases performed to date in the world.

Our team has been pioneering since 2012 the simplified "transfemoral minimalist approach" which then became the default strategy for TAVI, able to be applied in > 90% of all cases. To address the demand of many colleagues wishing to assess with us the feasibility and safety of this simplified strategy, we have started a series of interactive workshops based on live video-transmission of « minimalist transfemoral-TAVI cases » with various TAVI valves.

Due to COVID pandemic the next workshop of June 2021 will be virtual

Live cases will be transmitted from the Department of Cardiology of Rouen University Hospital Charles Nicolle and from other European Institutions. In between, several lectures will be covering the topics of patients selection, CT Scan screening, tips and tricks for the transfemoral minimalist approach, difficult cases, valve-in valve procedures, and management of complications
