
NYS Rechargeable Battery Recycling Law

Beginning June 8, 2011 retailers that sell covered rechargeable batteries will be required to accept used rechargeable batteries from consumers at no cost to the consumer during normal business hours.

Batteries covered by the law include:

- Nickel-cadmium
- Sealed lead
- Lithium ion
- Nickel metal hydride
- Any other such dry cell battery capable of being charged
- Battery packs containing any of the above mentioned batteries



A retailer must accept up to 10 batteries per day from any person regardless of whether they purchase replacement batteries or a retailer must accept as many batteries as a consumer purchases from the retailer.
