Local Law NO. 1 Year 2009 Village of Adams, New York

## AMENDING VILLAGE OF ADAMS LOCAL LAW RELATING TO PEDDLING, ARTICLE 15

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Adams as follows:

Said local law of the Village of Adams shall be amended as follows:

Section 2 shall be removed in its entirety to be replaced with the following:

Section 2. All persons desiring to sell, hawk or peddle goods, wares or merchandise from house to house or on the streets of said Village and all persons desiring to sell, hawk, vend or offer to sell produce which has not been grown or produced by themselves, their principals or their employees, before doing so, must obtain from the Village Clerk a license to do so at the annual fee, as determined by the Village Board, or a daily fee as determined by the Village Board. Such license shall be valid from March 1<sup>st</sup>, of each year until midnight of the last day of February of the year following.

Section 3 shall be removed in its entirety to be replaced with the following:

Section 3. Penalties for Offenses: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Local Law shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$250. Each day of continued violation is a separate and distinct offense.
