The British Poker Open™ is a series of 10 events at the Aspers Casino. The player who wins the most HROY points during the series will win the British Poker Championship.

General Rules for All Events:

1. *NO TOURNAMENT FEES FOR PLAYERS WHO REGISTER BY 12 PM.
2. Players with late entries and re-entries pay the tournament fee.
3. All events are 7-handed. Unofficial final tables are 9-handed.
4. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with three 60-second time banks each day.
5. Players at the featured table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Featured tables will have a 30-minute broadcast delay.
6. Director will draw the number of hands to play in the final 10 minutes of the day.
7. Players must be 18 years of age to participate.
8. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

BPO #1 – £10K NLH

£10,000 plus £500* buy-in

September 2nd at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 100,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.

5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #2 – £10K PLO

£10,000 plus £500* buy-in

September 3rd at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #3 – £10K NLH

£10,000 plus £500* buy-in

September 4th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 100,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #4 – £10K Short Deck

£10,000 plus £500* buy-in

September 5th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 300,000 in tournament chips (three 100K bullets).
4. All bullets must be redeemed by the close of registration.
5. Levels are 30 minutes on Day 1 with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #5 – £25K NLH

£25,000 plus £1000* buy-in

September 6th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #6 – £25K NLH

£25,000 plus £1000* buy-in

September 7th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.

2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #7 – \$25K PLO

£25,000 plus £1000* buy-in

September 8th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #8 – £25K NLH

£25,000 plus £1,000* buy-in

September 9th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
3. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #9 – £50K NLH

£50,000 plus £2,000* buy-in

September 10th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a single re-entry option.
2. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
3. Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels.
4. Players may re-enter once through the first 10 levels.
5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.

BPO #10 – £100K NLH

£100,000 plus £3,000* buy-in

September 11th at 12 pm

1. This is a two-day event with a single re-entry option.
2. Players start with 200,000 in tournament chips.
3. Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels.
4. Players may re-enter once through the first 10 levels.
5. Players will play 14 levels on Day 1. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.
