



## 2021 US Poker Open®

### June 3 – June 15

The US Poker Open is a series of 12 events. The player who wins the most PokerGO Tour points during the series will win the US Poker Open Championship and the \$50K first place prize and the Golden Eagle Trophy.

#### General Rules for All Events:

1. **\*NO TOURNAMENT FEES FOR PLAYERS WHO REGISTER BY 12 PM.**
2. Late entries and re-entries will pay the designated tournament fee.
3. The 10K and 25K events are double re-entry. The 50K event is single re-entry.
4. Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels. All events are two days.
5. NLH tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed once registration closes. All other events are seated 7-handed and switch to 6-handed once registration closes.
6. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with six 30-second time banks each day. Unused time banks can be used the next day. The final 6 players will receive 6 additional time banks.
7. Dinner break starts at the end of level 6. Registration is open until the end of dinner break.
8. TD will draw the number of hands to play in the final 10 minutes of the day.
9. Unofficial final tables are 8-handed for NLH events and are 7-handed for all other events.
10. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.
11. Players at the featured table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Featured tables will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay.
12. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
13. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.

14. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
