## **Payouts for All Events:**

## **General Rules for All Events:**

- 1. \*NO TOURNAMENT FEES FOR PLAYERS WHO REGISTER BY 12 PM.
- 2. Players must be in the registration line by 12 pm sharp to qualify for the waiver.
- 3. The late entries and re-entries will pay the designated tournament fee.
- 4. NLH tables are 7-handed. Unofficial final tables are 9-handed.
- 5. PLO and short deck tables are seated 7-handed and switch to 6-handed once registration closes. Unofficial final tables are 7-handed.
- 6. BB and 8G events are 6-handed. Unofficial final tables are 7-handed.
- 7. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with six 30-second time banks each day. Unused time banks can be used the next day.
- 8. Players at the featured table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Featured tables will have a 30-minute broadcast delay.
- 9. Director will draw the number of hands to play in the final 10 minutes of the day.
- 10. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 11. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 12. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
- 13. This tournament is subject to NRS 463.362.

# Poker Masters #1 – \$10K NLH

\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in November 4<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 2. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 3. Players start with 100,000 in tournament chips.
- 4. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 5. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

# Poker Masters #2 – \$10K PLO

\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in November 5<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

## Poker Masters #3 – \$10K Short Deck

\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in November 6<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 300,000 in tournament chips (three 100K bullets).
- 5. All bullets must be redeemed by the close of registration.
- 6. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 7. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

#### Poker Masters #4 – \$10K 8G

\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in November 7<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

## Poker Masters #5 – \$10K BB (NLH, PLO, D27 NL)

\$10,000 plus \$500\* buy-in November 8<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.

- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

#### Poker Masters #6 – \$25K NLH

- 4. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

#### Poker Masters #8 – \$25K NLH

\$25,000 plus \$1,000\* buy-in November 11<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

#### Poker Masters #9 – \$50K NLH

\$50,000 plus \$2000\* buy-in November 12<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a double re-entry option.
- 3. Players may re-enter twice through the first 9 levels.
- 4. Players start with 150,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Levels are 30 minutes with a 10-minute break every 3 levels.
- 6. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 start time is 12 pm.

# Poker Masters #10 – \$100K NLH

\$100,000 plus \$3,000\* buy-in November 13<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm

- 1. Aria will waive the tournament fee for players who play day 2 in the prior event.
- 2. This is a two-day event with a single re-entry option.
- 3. Players start with 200,000 in tournament chips.
- 4. Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels.
- 5. Players may re-enter once through the first 10 levels.
- 6. Players will play 14 levels on Day 1. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.
