

knowledge and consent of all participants.

- iii. Possession or distribution of photos, sound recordings, or videos of individuals under the age of 18 engaging in sexual activity and/or nudity (full or partial) is prohibited.

k. **Failure to Comply**

- i. Failure to comply with the directions of authorized University officials in the performance of their duties.
- ii. Failure to comply with the directions of authorized community safety officials in the performance of their duties (i.e. Law Enforcement Personnel, Emergency Medical Personnel, Fire Department Personnel, Emergency Management, etc.).
- iii. Failure to comply with reasonable requests of other students.
- iv. Failure to comply or complete a Student Community Standards Outcome.

l. **Guests**

Students are responsible for the actions of their guests and are responsible for ensuring their guests adhere to all University policies.

m. **Harassment**

Harassment is behavior that creates a hostile or intimidating environment in which verbal or physical conduct, because of its severity or persistence, is likely to unreasonably interfere with an individual's work environment, educational environment, living environment, or environment for participation in University activities.

n. **Hazing**

Hazing is defined as any conduct which subjects another person (whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically) to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the organization's intent or the person's consent or lack of consent.
