Find out?




You enter the next room. The door wasn't very warm, but this room is hot.

Water from the sink?

Extinguisher?





BZZT!

Throwing water on an electrical fire risks electrocution.

Try again?

You grab the extinguisher.

You see: Same size flame coming out of the inside of the toaster.

You hear: A smoke alarm.

Uh oh, this isn't usable.

I can't use this yet.

Looks good! Use it.







Charged.

Works on electrical fires.



Why isn't this usable?

Try again?

The flame flickers out, but a moment later, it's back.

You see: A flame coming out of the inside of the toaster.

You hear: A smoke alarm.

Unplug?



You unplug the toaster.

You see: A flame coming out of the inside of the toaster.

You hear: A smoke alarm.

Extinguisher?





You grab the extinguisher.

You see: Same size flame coming out of the inside of the toaster.

You hear: A smoke alarm.

Uh oh, this isn't usable.

Leave?

Looks good!







Charged.

Works on electrical fires.



Why isn't this usable?

Try again?

You follow the instructions on the extinguisher. The fire goes out, and stays out.

Success!

Call my friend

You exit the house, call 9-1-1, and let your friend know what's happened. Great job!
