November 2022 One more step



November is traditionally a month for remembering the events of the past and those who have died whose memories we treasure. This year this season has an added poignancy as we move towards the final act of

worship at St Wilfrid's Church. It has been a long journey from the original discussions and decisions made over 5 years ago and there have been many twists and turns on the way. But we are now nearing the end of this part of the journey.



On October 12th we welcomed many former members of the congregation and Bishop Ian Brackley to give thanks for all that had been and to celebrate the life and worship of that Church over the years. Then on Nov 3 rd we gathered, with other former members, to remember and pray for the repose of the souls of all who have faithfully served that

community over the years. There will be a final Coffee Morning at IOam on Nov I2th to say 'farewell'. After that the current regular congregation will gather with Bishop Jonathan to mark the closure of the building in a eucharist. This is very much the time for him as our chief pastor, along with Revds Sam and Kate and Fr Bob, to offer support and prayer to those who will be most affected by this step.



We hope that you will understand the need for this to be just for that group rather than a general celebration. However, we do hope that as many of us as possible will be at St Mary's after I I am on that day (Nov 20th) to welcome Bishop Jonathan and those

who have gathered with him as they place the Statue and Banner of St Wilfrid – and the Eucharistic vessels – in their new home. This is a sign and symbol of the ongoing life of that community within the wider life of the Parish.



The Season we are in is also known as 'Kingdom season' and this reminds that the kingdom of God that we all seek is not confined by time or space, is not held within walls or buildings, but is made of the living

stones, the people of God who are a pilgrim people. The hymn 'One more step' reminds us that we are called to journey through life with all its trials, challenges, joys and celebrations aware of the presence of God with us each step of the way. As the people of St Wilfrid's take the next step on their journey of faith please pray for them, and those who support them, that they may be aware of the presence of Christ in joy and in sorrow, and may continue to walk with him as part of the parish community



We will also be welcoming to St Mary's Church in November 'The Museum of the Moon'. This is a light installation that has at its heart a 7m illuminated globe of the Moon. Those who have visited it elsewhere in the

country (last year at Chichester Cathedral) have all spoken of how impressive and beautiful it is — and we hope that everyone will come and enjoy the installation. There are a number of events (listed below) associated with 'We Shine' and we are expecting to have a large number of visitors. If you could help us in welcoming them for a couple of hours please see the list in Church or contact one of the Ministry Team.



The **Parish Autumn Fayre** took place on Oct 29th and there was a good atmosphere of us working together as a team (over 50 volunteers) welcoming in those who

came to the Fair. There have been many thanks and positive comments on social media from those who visited – and we also **raised £1250**thank you to all who supported it in anyway!

This year for Advent we are inviting you to join us in a 'Feast for Advent'. This is the title of a book by Delia



Smith and we will be exploring it together at Wednesday Fellowship lunches, Saturday Breakfasts and on online book club (contact Revd Sam for Zoom link). More details will be available at the end of November – but in the meantime if you want to get a copy of the book we have some in stick in the Parish and can order more ... please let us know!



Also this year is the 20th anniversary of the Churches Homeless Action '**Comfort and Joy' voucher scheme**. As in previous years we will be collecting donations of Gift vouchers/cards (£5) and a Christmas card.
