In the Parish of St Mary's, Portsea With St Faith's Landport



As the sounds of the Parish Panto fade away for another year, and as the signs of Spring begin to appear around us we turn our hearts and minds towards Lent and the journey to Easter.

Each year in the Parish we invite you to join us on this journey and to reflect on the journey we make through our lives with Jesus, and the journey he makes for us to the Cross.

This year we will be using the material from the national church, and so joining with Christians across the country and we reflect on 'Dust and Glory.'

The Archbishops' in their introduction say:

This Lent we are all invited to explore how we can live well with the mess of everyday life. It encourages us to take a fresh look at the frustrations and failings that every day brings, and rather than pretending we can always avoid them, seek to learn from then and grow closer to God through them,



After all the changes and experiences of the last couple of years, and the disruption to our patterns of life and worship we hope that each of us will use Lent this year as a chance to re-establish our life of worship and to deepen our lives of prayer.

There are a variety of ways you can share in this journey with us. There is a copy of the Daily Reflections book available from Church (we will be giving them out on Sunday Feb 19th, please let us know if you need one sent to you). There is also a small booklet for children and young people to use. Alternatively you can follow the reflections on line or on social media – see the Church of England website or pages for details.



We will be continuing with our regular times for worship both in our churches and online.

We will mark the start if Lent with two special services on **Ash Wednesday (Feb 22**nd) – both at **St Mary's** There will be a service at **Noon** followed by Fellowship Lunch (please bring your own food) and another at 7pm. **The Preacher at**

7pm will be Very Revd Nicholas Frayling.



Stations of the Cross Sun March 5th 4pm and Monday March 20th at 11am at St Mary's We use the 14 images on the pillars at the Church to reflect on Jesus's journey to the Cross (lasts about 30 mins)



Mothering Sunday March 19th at the 9.30am St St Faith's and 10am at St Mary's we will be giving thanks for all who care for us and sharing flowers as a sign of that thanks.



Feast of the Annunciation Sat March 25th – this is the day we recall the moment when the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and invited her to be the mother of Jesus. We will have a sung service at Noon at St Mary's



Sunday March 26th is Passion Sunday – as we enter the final fortnight of Lent, and focus our prayers and reflections on the passion and suffering of Jesus on the cross. At St Mary's we will have at 4pm Music and reflections for Passiontide

Details of our Holy Week services will follow – join us on Palm Sunday as we gather at St Faith's at 9.30am for our procession to St Mary's

Reflection and conversation

There will be 3 main opportunities to meet with others and reflect on the themes for each week

Wednesdays at St Mary's after the Noon Mass (please bring your own lunch) and share in a led conversation on the daily reflections.


