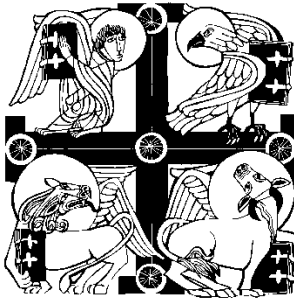

**As the Altar is prepared we sing the hymn**

*The words of the hymn are on the weekly notice sheet as the Offertory Hymn.*

*At the end of the hymn a prayer is offered at the end of which*

*After the Priest has recalled the words of Jesus at the Last Supper*

*If you are at Church please come forward to the Dais to receive standing – please respect other people's space. If you wish to receive where you are seated at the distanced seats, please remain standing until you have received.*

*During Communion the Choir will sing an anthem, and if there is a communion hymn you will find it on the separate sheet*
