

# *Faith, Failure and Forgiveness*

## *Holy Week 2023*



At the heart of our community of faith is the journey to the Cross and then the empty tomb of Easter Day. This is a **journey of love and forgiveness**– God's generous and forgiving love for us shown in the sacrifice made by Jesus. It is this love that shapes us and which we are called to reflect and be a sign of in our lives both as individuals and as a community.

Each year **we are invited to share that journey** and reflect on what it means for us, as we share in the special service of Holy Week and Easter. But it is a week that we have 'lost' in some ways for the last 3 years – so for some we will have forgotten how special and important the services are; for others it will be a new experience, and for some it will be something we need to re-engage with.

**Perhaps this year as we continue to emerge from the impact of Covid we could all make that extra effort and commit ourselves to walk together from the joy of the Palm Procession to the discovery of the Risen Christ on Easter Day**

We will be welcoming a **guest preacher** to help us reflect on this journey . On **Monday Tuesday and Wednesday evening at 7pm** there will be a Mass with hymns at St Mary's – at the end of which **Canon Kathryn Percival** (from the Cathedral) **will reflect with us on Faith, Failure and Forgiveness.**

At **St Mary's** from Maundy Thursday to Easter Day **Fr Bob will be our preacher** and help us to reflect on the events we are sharing in and how they affect our lives today. St Faith's will have their own pattern for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday – and then we will be together to celebrate the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday together at St Mary's at 8.30pm.

## Sunday April 2nd Palm Sunday



**9.30am** Those who can please **join us at St Faith's Church in Crasswell Street** as we walk with **Palm crosses**, streamers and a band and begin the journey to the Cross ...



**10am** We gather as a Parish at **St Mary's** to 'welcome' Jesus as the crowds welcomed him into Jerusalem. We also hear the Passion Narrative to help us recall the events that we are about to share in through the week,

We will use the 14 images around the Church to reflect on the journey made on Good Friday from Pilate to the Cross and the tomb – and the journey we make through life with Jesus

## Maundy Thursday April 6<sup>th</sup>



At our services we reflect on the events of the Last Supper – the washing of the disciples feet; Jesus breaking bread and sharing the cup inviting us to do this in remembrance of him and then he asks us to 'watch and pray with him' in the Garden of Gethsemane till he is betrayed by Judas.

**At St Faith's 6pm Eucharist of the Last Supper**

ending with a short watch and vigil of prayer

**At St Mary's 7.30pm Eucharist of the Last Supper**

**and watch of prayer till Midnight.** Please sign list n Church if you can cover some of the watch of prayer ...be good to have 2 or 3 people for every 15 min slot



## **Good Friday April 7<sup>th</sup>**



Our churches are stripped and empty – our focus is on the Cross and all it stands for and means. We hear the reading of the events of the first Good Friday in John's Gospel; we reflect on the cross, pray at the foot of the cross and end in stillness receiving the Body of Christ
