Walk in the Light of Easter *Apríl* 2023



As we have journeyed to the Cross and tomb through Holy Week so we continue to journey together as we celebrate the light and joy of Easter. Over the coming days and weeks we hope that you will find time and space to gather with us as we reflect on the risen life of Jesus and how we are called to be signs of that life to others.

This year we will be combining that expression of hope for the future and new life with our **preparing for the Coronation of King Charles III**. The Church of England is inviting us to use the 4 weeks that lead to the Coronation to pause and reflect each day and pray for our King and Queen and the Royal Family; for our country and the Commonwealth; and for all of us that in our lives we may follow the example of our Servant King, Jesus, who calls us to walk with him.

On Easter Day we will be sharing a special booklet which has been produced to guide you through those days with reflections and prayers. There is also material online and we will be sharing that on our social media pages. We invite you to find time and space each day – but particularly to consider pausing with us at 9 & 6 and offer a prayer at that time for our King as he prepares for his Coronation.

On Easter Day we will also be celebrating Baptisms at both St Mary's and St Faith's – please hold in your prayers Eliza, Esme, Jospeh, Lucas, Lylie, Linsey, Pearl, Penny, Tayo – and they will also be walking with us and our King as faithful servants of our Servant King. Many of them are also exploring faith with us as they prepare for **Confirmation** later in the year (on June 8th) – we hope you will support them on that day (a Thursday in the evening) and encourage them in their faith.

As we celebrate Easter we also look forward to that other celebration of life and joy in Fratton – **the May Fayre**. This year on **Monday May** I^{st} – please spread the word; ensure you have volounteered; sold raffle tickets; brought in items to sell; and started baking cakes! We need each

and everyone of us to be involved and share in the event – welcoming 10,000+ visitors to the church and churchyard.

The PCC met recently and considered the current situation with COVID – which while seeming to decrease is still in the community. It agreed that we will move towards the sharing of the Chalice, but not yet. The situation wil be regularly reviewed and we will discuss how best to ensure all are comfortable with what is possible. However, the PCC has invited those who previously helped with administering the Chalice before COVID to begin to assist on Sundays in holding the chalice for the Minister who will intinct the host. If you have any thoughts or views you wish to share then please let one of the Ministry team know.

Lastly, **thank you** to all who have supported our study, discussion and worship over the last few weeks. Also thank you to those who will have enhanced our worship over the Tridium (Maundy Thursday to Easter Day) with their serving, reading, music and preparing the items we use at the services. Finally, thank you to those who have cleaned, polished and decorated our Churches for our Easter Celebrations
